The UK chapter provides a practical end-to-end guide to conducting internal investigations in the UK, walking through every stage from initial scoping and team structure through document review, witness interviews, and forensic accounting, to reporting and engagement with enforcement authorities. It also addresses the key legal and regulatory considerations that arise throughout, including privilege, data protection, whistleblower protections, corporate criminal liability, and the strategic decision of whether to self-report and cooperate with authorities such as the SFO with a view to securing a Deferred Prosecution Agreement or Civil Recovery Order.
