Rob observed that the collapse of an unregulated entity shifts scrutiny towards the regulated parties surrounding it. "Very often with the collapse of an entity which is not itself regulated, the spotlight falls on lenders, auditors and other firms which are accountable to regulators," he said.

Rob also noted that unregulated finance means a lower degree of protection for consumers when things go wrong.
