He has served as the firm's New York Office Managing Partner since 2022, and also founded the Zimroth Center on the Administration of Criminal Law at NYU School of Law.

Co-Chair of Jenner & Block's nationally recognized Content, Media, and Entertainment Practice and Technology Practice, Alison advises media organizations, technology and video game companies, and film and television studios on high-stakes litigation and complex content matters. She also co-chairs the firm's AI Task Force, counseling clients on AI litigation, licensing, and governance. Alison represents News Corp in its AI copyright litigation against Perplexity, and also advises Meta on its external Oversight Board, content moderation, and on strategic and legal questions concerning its Wearables products.

Co-Chair of the firm's Litigation Department and Investigations, Compliance, and Defense Practice, Damian joined Jenner in June 2025 and has since advised corporations, institutions, and individuals on criminal defense, government investigations, crisis management, and regulatory enforcement. He previously served as US Attorney for the Southern District of New York from 2021 to 2024, where he oversaw landmark prosecutions including those of FTX founder Sam Bankman-Fried, US Senator Bob Menendez, and Archegos Capital founder Bill Hwang.
