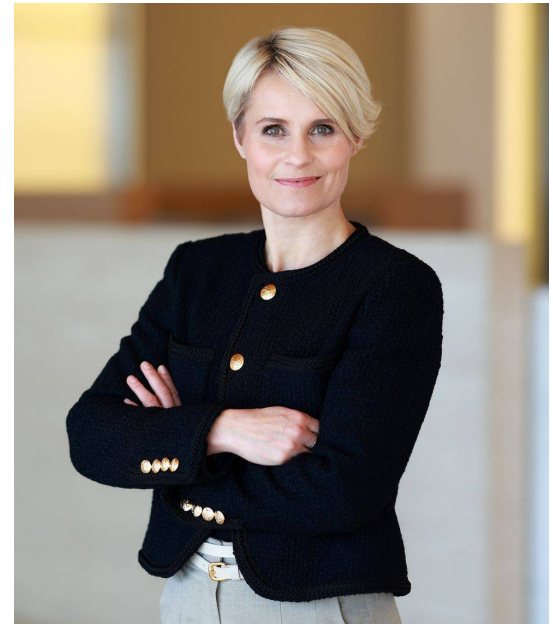

### Overview
