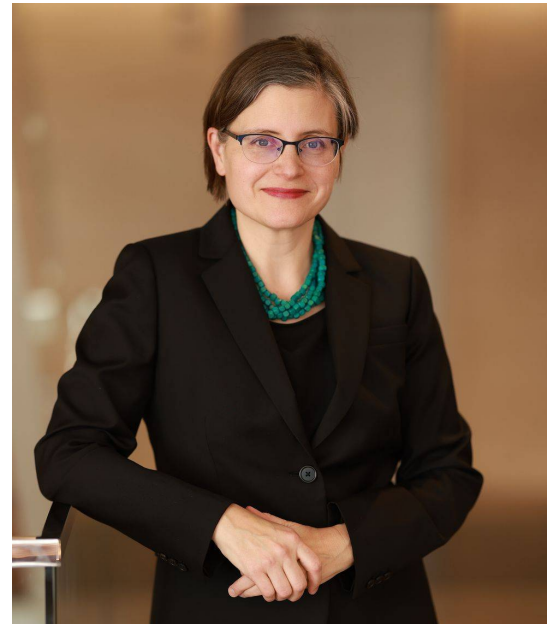

Overview
