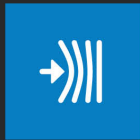

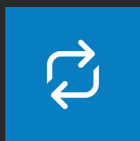
Being a Resilient Lawyer in Challenging Times

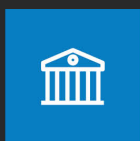
**LGBTQ Cultural Competency:

The legal profession continues to maintain significant gaps in LGBTQ inclusion, according to the latest NALP Report on Diversity. The June 2020 Supreme Court Bostock decision has made addressing this problem even more relevant. The final leg of the CLE Relay is reserved for our Annual Supreme Court Term in Review. This dynamic, timely CLE program will feature Ian Heath Gershengorn, former Acting Solicitor General of the United States and current chair of our Appellate and Supreme Court Practice. He will be joined by other members of the nationally recognized group, including Partners Jessie Amunson, Ishan Bhabha, Matt Hellman, Tassity Johnson, and Adam Unikowsky.

Panelists will engage in a lively and informative discussion on the recent past, current, and future US Supreme Court terms. They will focus on the vast changes in the Administration and the Court's structure, covering the post-Justice Kennedy landscape and a tribute to Justice Ginsburg, as well as an overview and analysis of Justice Barrett's first term. The panel will also discuss high-profile cases surrounding religion, the election and associated voting issues, the revitalization of the Affordable Care Act, collegiate athletes, and big tech. They will also share their predictions on the next term with respect to abortion, Second Amendment, and Affirmative Action cases.
