On February 16, 2021, Acting Secretary of the US Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) Norris Cochran, published in the Federal Register the Sixth Amendment to the Declaration Under the Public Readiness and Emergency Act [PREP Act]. 86 Fed. This is the second amendment to the Declaration issued since President Biden took office and continues the Trump Administration's practice of providing broad liability protection for those responding to COVID-19.
