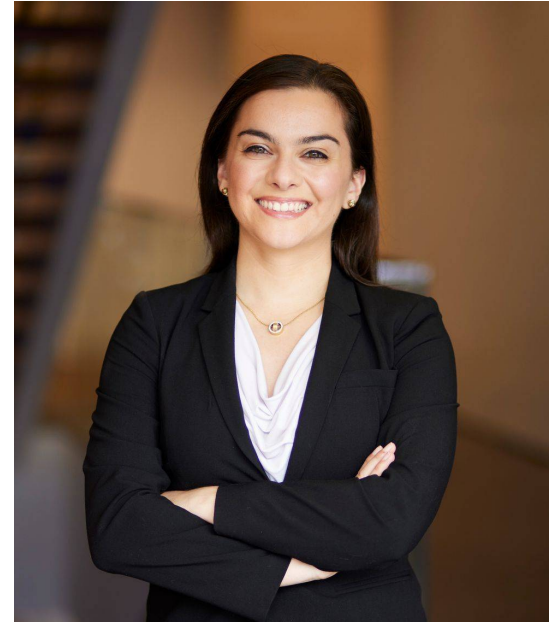

Overview

Christina Isnardi helps communications, media, internet, and technology companies navigate complex regulatory, litigation, and compliance issues. On litigation matters, she assists these clients resolve disputes ranging from antitrust class-actions to employment actions, such as worker classification issues arising from app-based platforms.

Christina maintains an active pro bono practice that promotes compliance with employment and civil rights laws. She has represented several national civil rights organizations as amici in federal district and appellate courts on pressing non-discrimination matters, such as advocating for equal access to healthcare and within the criminal legal system. She counsels on workplace disputes and revamps clients' employment policies to stay up to date on evolving legal landscapes across jurisdictions. Christina also serves on the firm's Associates Committee and works with firm counsel to update and implement firm policies.

Before joining Jenner & Block, Christina was a regulatory associate at a leading international law firm. During law school, she served as a judicial extern for Hon. Denny Chin of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, where she assisted on high-profile constitutional law cases. She also worked as a law clerk in the general counsel's office of a Fortune 100 company as well as in an employment practice of a law firm representing clients on compensation and discrimination matters in federal and state court. At Columbia Law School, she served as an Articles Editor and published author for the Columbia Journal of Transnational Law.
