### Overview

Doug has a track record of delivering results in pivotal matters. He has obtained dismissals of antitrust cases for numerous clients, and some of his most substantial wins have come on appeal in antitrust cases where the district court erroneously ruled against his client. In *St. Luke's Hospital et al v. ProMedica et al*, Doug argued and secured a unanimous Sixth Circuit reversal of a preliminary injunction that had barred his client from terminating contractual relationships with competitor St. Luke's. This decision has become a leading precedent on a firm's duty to deal with competitors under antitrust laws.

Prior to entering private practice, Doug was at the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), where he played a central role in several antitrust investigations and high-profile litigations. He was twice awarded the FTC's Janet D. Steiger Award for his outstanding contributions in key litigations, as well as its prestigious Stephen Nye Award for his contribution to the FTC trial team in *FTC et al. v. St. Luke's Hospital Sys. et al.*
