

# Client Alert: SMO v TikTok – Another UK Representative Action Survives, For Now

A UK High Court decision of 8 March 2022 in the case of *SMO v TikTok, Inc. and Others* has attracted attention in the wake of the UK Supreme Court's decision last year in *Lloyd v Google*. The Supreme Court's decision put the future of representative actions for breaches of data protection law in England in doubt. *SMO v TikTok, Inc.*, another representative action, has survived an initial hurdle, but it remains to be seen whether the action will be allowed to continue to a full trial.
