She represents clients, including elected officials, election or redistricting commissions, party committees, nonprofits, and voters in cases involving redistricting, voting rights, and campaign finance before state and federal courts and congressional bodies. This past year, she argued before the US Supreme Court on behalf of Katie Hobbs, the Arizona secretary of state, in *Brnovich v.
