She has served in two presidential administrations and is actively engaged in politics, including running for New York City Public Advocate in a 2019 special election. She currently serves on the boards of the Roosevelt Institute and the Stone Barns Center for Food and Agriculture. Ms. Smalls also served as a national board member for the American Constitution Society from 2015 to 2021.
