Ambassador Harper, a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, is the first Native American to be named a US Ambassador, serving as US Permanent Representative to the UN Human Rights Council from 2014 to 2017. From 2010 to 2014, Ambassador Harper served on the President's Commission on White House Fellowships. Today, Ambassador Harper serves as chair of Jenner & Block's Native American Law Practice.
