On June 9, Partner Lindsay Harrison will lead an introductory session on the US Supreme Court during Street Law, Inc. and the Supreme Court Historical Society's 2022 Supreme Court Summer Institute for Teachers. Ms. Harrison's session will provide an overview of the operation of the Court, including how it decides to hear cases, the "shadow docket," briefing and oral arguments, and the process for issuing opinions.
