Jenner & Block Partner Kirsten Spira shared her insight on the use of experts in legal malpractice litigation in a panel presentation titled “Use of Experts in Legal Malpractice Matters – Maximizing the Impact of Your Expert.” Speaking at the Fall 2022 National Legal Malpractice Conference sponsored by the ABA’s Standing Committee on Lawyers’ Professional Liability, she and other panelists discussed the subject by dividing the issues presented into innings of a baseball game.
