The case challenged communications between the federal government and social media platforms to remove posts on various topics such as the 2020 election and Covid-19. The states asserted injury on two counts: violation of states’ right to speak and constituents’ right to listen. Although the states did not win *Murthy*, the case demonstrated the advancement of states attorneys general cases involving broad theories of standing.
