The authors also analyze the removal of the bifacial solar panel exclusion to safeguard duties, expansion of the tariff-rate quota from 5 gigawatts to 12.5 gigawatts, and increased duties under Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974, as amended.

“The recent trade actions are intended to protect the government’s significant investments designed to bolster clean energy development while at the same time boosting domestic manufacturing capabilities and the purchase of domestically produced goods,” the authors write.
