Overview

Before that, she was a Senior Counsel for Appellate Matters in the Environment and Natural Resources Division of the DOJ, where she led high-profile environmental litigation before the DC Circuit and other federal appellate courts. Prior to joining the DOJ, Meghan worked in private practice as an associate at an AmLaw 10 law firm.

Meghan has extensive knowledge in power and energy transition, advising clients on regulatory policies under the Inflation Reduction Act, carbon sequestration initiatives, and clean energy development. She has deep expertise in greenhouse gas regulations, having handled litigation involving the EPA’s methane and power sector rules, and has played a key role in shaping policies on emissions standards and regulatory compliance. Her background extends to the regulation of hazardous substances, guiding clients on Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), and Clean Water Act (CWA) compliance while mitigating risks associated with hazardous substance management and remediation. Additionally, she counsels corporations on environmental justice and ESG strategies, helping businesses navigate sustainability

initiatives, regulatory obligations, and litigation risks to ensure compliance with evolving legal and policy expectations.
